Resident Event Photo/Video How-To, Tips, and Tricks

GETTING STARTED

- 1. Clean Your Lens: Wipe your lens with a soft fabric (t-shirt, towel) to prevent blurry or grainy photos.
- 2. **Choose the Best Phone:** Use an iPhone 12 or newer for high-quality shots. Test different phones among staff for the clearest footage.
- 3. **Opt for Good Lighting**: Shoot in natural light or well-lit areas for clear and vibrant images.

PORTRAIT VS LANDSCAPE

- 1. Hold your phone vertically (potrait) for most all photo and video!
- 2. **Optimal Formatting:** Portrait orientation fills the screen properly and looks visually appealing on platforms like Instagram stories/reels.
- 3. **Group Shots:** Use the wide-angle lens setting (0.5x) for group shots to capture everyone in the frame while keeping It vertical.

WHAT TO CAPTURE?

- 1. Candid Moments & Group Shots: Capture residents naturally mingling, laughing, and gather residents for quick group photos.
- 2. Event Highlights: Snap action shots of meal times, raffles, games, etc.
- 3. Behind-the-Scenes: Document event setup, preparation, and cleanup.
- 4. **Boomerangs:** Use the boomerang feature, a short video clip that plays forwards and then backwards in a loop. Created using smartphone apps or a feature within social media platforms like Instagram.
- 5. **Longer Videos:** Set your phone on a counter/tripod and film short clips of events for longer-form videos; we'll handle the editing.

TIPS FOR GREAT CONTENT

- 1. Take as many shots as possible and pick the best ones later!
- 2. Play with portrait mode for close ups, detail shots, or 3x for zoom.
- 3. Remember to capture photos with residents in them. These shots consistently show the highest engagement and performance rates.
- 4. Ensure fingers are out of the screen when capturing and clean your lens!
- 5. Ask resident If they prefer to take a selfie Instead of having their photo taken! They can either send It to you, or directly to the Instagram Inbox.

SENDING PHOTO/VIDEO

- 1. Submit photos and videos within 24-36 hours after events!
- 2. Email or text attachments to Coco or Kirby (contact Information below).
- 3. Send content via Instagram Direct Message to property's account.
- 4. Use Google Drive or cloud folder for larger files.
